➤ **Purpose and goals of the student section**

The student section creates a space for academic debate for students and young researchers who analyse contemporary risks and the resilience of economies, societies and institutions from economic, social, political, technological, legal and cultural perspectives.

➤ **Target audience:** undergraduate and postgraduate students; members of student research groups

➤ **Thematic scope**

- **Geopolitics and Global Risks:** contemporary crises through the eyes of young people; armed conflicts and their economic consequences; disinformation and information warfare; energy and material crises; climate change and environmental challenges; long-term effects of the pandemic
- **Resilience of Economies and Societies:** labour market (youth, migration, NEET), social inequalities and exclusion, economic and social security, role of education and human capital, national minorities: integration, rights, public policies and social capital
- **Integration and International Security:** the EU as a mechanism of economic stabilization; NATO and security in Central and Eastern Europe, the role of the USA in the security system, cross-border cooperation between Lithuania and Poland, national minorities in international relations and societal resilience in the region
- **Technology, Innovation and Resilience:** cybersecurity, artificial intelligence and economic security, innovation as a driver of resilience, green transition and the future of energy

➤ **Form of session:** student presentations (10–12 minutes + discussion); moderation by academic staff; passive participation (listener)

➤ **Publication options for selected papers:** “Academic Review of Business and Economics” (scientific journal of University of Economics in Katowice); “Vox Legis” (student journal of SWPS University); Yearbook of the Association of Polish Scientists in Lithuania

➤ **Key dates**

- Submission of participation with paper title and short abstract – by 15 April 2026
- Acceptance notifications – on a rolling basis
- Conference programme announcement – by 15 May 2026
- Full paper submission – by 30 June 2026
